BADMINTON RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG Badminton competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following 7 events:
- 1.2.1 Individual Events
 - A Men's Singles
 - B Men's Doubles
 - C Women's Singles
 - D Women's Doubles
 - E Mixed Doubles
 - 1.2.2 Team Events
 - A Men's Team (3 singles & 2 doubles)
 - B Women's Team (3 singles & 2 doubles)
- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 1.3.1 A maximum of **8** men competitors, **8** women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
 - 1.3.2 Individual Events: Maximum of 2 entries per event. **Each competitor may compete in a maximum of 3 individual events.**
 - 1.3.3 Team Events: 1 team per event (maximum of **8** competitors and minimum of 4 competitors per team).

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 2.1 Individual Events Competition Format
- 2.1.1 The seeding in the individual draw is based on the BWF ranking.
 - 2.1.2 The individual events will be conducted in a knock-out format **with a maximum of 22 entries per individual event.**
 - 2.1.3 Losers of semi-finals will compete in the bronze medal match.
 - 2.1.4 Winners of the semi-finals will compete in the gold medal match.

2.2 Team Events Competition Format - with 5 or less teams

2.2.1 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played in which the teams shall play against each other in a single group league to decide the ranking of the entries.

2.2.2 Phase 2: The teams ranked 1st & 2nd will play the gold medal match and the teams ranked 3rd & 4th will play the bronze medal match.

2.3 Team Events Competition Format - with 6 or more teams

2.3.1 The competition will be divided into 2 groups, Group A & Group B, in which the winner in the previous AUG badminton competition shall be seeded in Group A and the silver medal team in Group B.

2.3.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.

2.3.3 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 2 groups in which the teams shall play against each other. The top 2 ranked teams of each group will advance to the semi-finals, and the rest of the teams will play in the classification matches, if applicable.

2.3.4 Phase 2: Semi-Finals: 1A vs 2B and 2A vs 1B.
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.

2.3.5 If there are 7 and less teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5th, 6th and 7th positions. This is to ensure that all teams get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.

2.4 Team Events - Ranking of Teams in Phase 1

2.4.1 The following league points system will apply:

Win	2 points
Loss	0 point

2.4.2 The ranking within the group is determined by the greater number of league points obtained in all group matches.

2.4.3 If 2 teams ended phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the winner of the match between these 2 teams will be awarded the higher placing.

2.4.4 If 3 or more teams ended phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the following tie-breaking mechanism shall apply:

A The match difference using results from matches only among the tied teams

B The game difference using results from matches only among the tied teams

- C The point difference using results from matches only among the tied teams
- D The match difference using results from all matches
- E The game difference using results from all matches
- F The point difference using results from all matches

2.5 **Format of Play**

2.5.1 Rally point system: 3 x 15 points, Play will be in accordance with the laws of Badminton as mentioned on the BWF website.

2.6 **Match Attire**

2.6.1 The attire of participants must comply with BWF standard including:

- A Printing of the initials of players according to registered name.
- B Printing of the country names.
- C Height of letterings to be between 6-10cm for players' initials and 5-8cm for country name.
