## **DIVING RULES**

### **1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

- 1.1 The AUG Diving competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
  - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of World Aquatics.
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following 13 events:

- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 1.3.1 A maximum of 14 men competitors, 14 women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
  - 1.3.2 Individual Events: Maximum of 2 entries per event.
  - 1.3.3 Team Events: 1 team per event with maximum of 3 competitors per team. (2 teams are allocated for the host country).

### **2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS**

2.1 The ASEAN University Sports Council shall be responsible for the overall organisation and management of the Diving competitions of the 22<sup>nd</sup> ASEAN University Games 2026.

#### **2.2 Technical Organisation**

The ASEAN University Sports Council (AUSC), under the guidance of the Technical Delegate, appointed by the Malaysia Aquatics (MAS), is responsible for the technical organisation of the 22<sup>nd</sup> AUG Games Diving competitions.

### 2.3 Competition Format

All Individual and Synchronised events will be run as Finals. The Diving order in the Finals will be determined by computerised random selection.

The number of dives and restrictions on the Degree of Difficulty (DD) are as follows:

1m and 3m Springboard	6 dives without DD limit from 5 groups	5 dives without DD limit from 5 groups

3m Synchronised Springboard	2 dives from 5 groups.	5 dives from 5 groups. 2 dives with DD 2.0 for each dive and 3 dives without DD limit
10m Synchronised Platform	2 dives with DD 2.0 for each dive and 4 dives without DD limit	

Mixed Synchronised Event – To be performed on 3m springboard and 10m platform, shall comprise of five (5) rounds of dives from five (5) groups. Two (2) dives with DD2.0 and three (3) rounds without limit of DD

Team Diving – involves one male and one female diver. Comprise six (6) different dives from six (6) different groups. Two (2) dives with DD 2.0 each dive and four (4) dives without limit of degree of difficulty. Three (3) dives to be executed by female diver and the other three (3) dives by male diver. Three (3) dives from 3m springboard and three (3) dives from 10m platform. Each diver must perform at least one (1) dive from 3m springboard and one (1) dive from 10m platform. The two (2) dives with DD2.0 may be executed at any time and from any height by each team member, one (1) by the male and one (1) by the female.

In the Individual Platform events, divers may choose to dive-off from 5m, 7.5m or 10m.

In each round of Synchronised Diving events, both divers must perform the same dive. All dives must be done off 10m.

### 2.4 Tie-Break Procedures

In the event of a tie for the medal positions, a dive-off will be conducted for the affected divers or synchronised divers.

### 2.5 Disqualification Rules

Penalties, mainly in the form of deduction of points, may be imposed upon divers who infringed the World Aquatics Diving Rules. The penalties and disqualification procedures are sanctioned by the World Aquatics Rules.

#### 2.6 Official Draw

The Official Draw for Diving will occur as per World Aquatics regulations during the Team Leaders' briefing.

### **3 EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING**

#### 3.1 Competition Attire

Clothing worn by athletes at the 22<sup>nd</sup> AUG Games Diving Competition must comply with the World Aquatics Constitution.
