ARCHERY RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG Archery competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the World Archery Federation (WA).

- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following 10 events:

- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 1.3.1 A maximum of 8 men competitors, 8 women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
 - 1.3.2 Individual Events: Maximum of 4 competitors per event.
 - 1.3.3 Men & Women Team Events: For each men & women team event, maximum of 1 team of 3 competitors selected based on their best score in the individual qualification round.
 - 1.3.4 Mixed Team Events: For each mixed team event, maximum of 1 team of 2 competitors (1 man & 1 woman) selected based on their best scores in the individual qualification round.
- 1.4 Countries must confirm and submit their list of competitors at the General Technical Briefing.
- 1.5 Draw - After the final entries have been confirmed, the draw for target number and the shooting order will be held according to WA rules.
- 1.6 All archers must take part in the official practice schedule the day prior to the start of the competition. Any athlete not present will not be taken into consideration except for force majeure or previous approval from Technical Committee Chair.

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

2.1 Men & Women Team Events

- 2.1.1 If a country is unable to present a compound bow team for either men's or women's events, it shall be allowed to present a mixed team to compete in the men's compound bow event (1 man + 2 women, or 2 men + 1 woman). The selection criteria shall be determined by the competition rules.
- 2.1.2 The 8 best teams, each composed of 3 competitors selected by adding the best score of the 3 best competitors of the same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete.

2.2 Mixed Team Events

- 2.2.1 The 8 best teams, each composed of 2 competitors (1 man & 1 woman) selected by adding the best score of the best man and best woman competitors of the same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete.
- 2.2.2 To shoot in the elimination phase, the archers can be the same ones that make the qualification or any other ones that the delegation appoints. Once both archers are selected (deadline is before warm-up of the given competition starts), they shall not be replaced.
- 2.2.3 The selected man and woman must be from the same country and the same bow division.

2.3 System of Competition

- 2.3.1 During the Qualification Round, each archer will shoot 72 arrows (2 x 36 arrows) in 12 ends of 6 arrows.
- 2.3.2 The top 24 men and women individuals, the top 8 men and women teams and the top 8 mixed teams shall advance to the Elimination Rounds of respective events.

2.4 Qualification Round

- 2.4.1 During the Qualification Round, each archer will shoot 72 arrows (2 x 36 arrows) in 12 ends of 6 arrows.
- 2.4.2 Archers in recurve division will shoot at a distance of 70 meter using the 122cm target face while archers in compound division will shoot at a distance of 50 meter using the 80cm (6 rings) target face.

2.5 Elimination Round – Individual

- 2.5.1 Top 24 men and women individuals from the Qualification Round by each division shall advance to the Elimination Round.
- 2.5.2 All matches in recurve division will using a ‘set system’ while in compound division will using a ‘cumulative scoring’ based on the rules that have been set in WA rules.

2.6 Elimination Round – Team

- 2.6.1 Top 8 men and women teams from the Qualification Round by each division shall advance to the Elimination Round.
- 2.6.2 Each team composed of 3 archers selected by adding the best score of the 3 best archers of the same division and same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete.
- 2.6.3 All matches in recurve division will using a ‘set system’ while in compound division will using a ‘cumulative scoring’ based on the rules that have been set in WA rules.
- 2.6.4 Please fill up the team nomination form if there are any changes of the archers to compete in team event. That form must be submitted to the Chairman of Judges not less than 15 minutes before the team event started.

2.7 Elimination Round – Mixed Team

- 2.7.1 Top 8 men and women mixed teams from the Qualification Round by each division shall advance to the Elimination Round.
- 2.7.2 Each team composed of 2 archers (1 men and 1 women) selected by adding the best score of the best men and best women archers of the same division and same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete.
- 2.7.3 All matches in recurve division will using a ‘set system’ while in compound division will using a ‘cumulative scoring’ based on the rules that have been set in WA rules.
- 2.7.4 Please fill up the team nomination form if there are any changes of the archers to compete in mixed team event. That form must be submitted to the Chairman of Judges not less than 15 minutes before the mixed team event started.

- 2.8 Match Attire - The attire of participants must comply with WA standard.
- 2.9 Judge Commission - A Judge Commission will consist of a minimum of 2 WA International Judges or Continental Judges, and the number of NTOs shall be agreed between AUGOC and AUSC. A judge's decision is final with respect to the value of an arrow in a target and must be resolved before any arrow could be removed.
- 2.10 Medals Awarded - Each country can only be awarded a maximum of 2 medals per individual event.
