BASKETBALL RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG Basketball competition will be organised in accordance with:
 - 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the International Basketball Federation (FIBA).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following 2 events:
 - 1.2.1 Men's Tournament.
 - 1.2.2 Women's Tournament.
- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
 - 1.3.1 1 Men's Team: Maximum of 12 players and 5 team officials.
 - 1.3.2 1 Women's Team: Maximum of 12 players and 5 team officials.
- 1.4 Each country participating in the respective basketball tournaments must bring with them the following number of International Technical Official (ITO):
 - 1.4.1 Men's Tournament: 1 international FIBA or National Tier 1 elite referee.
 - 1.4.2 Women's Tournament: 1 international FIBA or National Tier 1 elite referee.

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 2.1 Competition Format - with 4 or 5 teams
 - 2.1.1 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played in which the teams shall play against each other in a single group league to decide the ranking of the team.
 - 2.1.2 Phase 2: The teams ranked 1st & 2nd will play the gold medal match and the teams ranked 3rd & 4th will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.2 Competition Format - with 6 or more teams
 - 2.2.1 The competition will be divided into 2 groups, Group A & Group B, in which the winner in the previous AUG basketball competition shall be seeded in Group A and the silver medal team in Group B.
 - 2.2.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and also the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.
 - 2.2.3 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 2 groups in which the teams shall play against each other (Group of 3 teams, competition format listed in 2.1 applies). The top 2 ranked teams of each group will advance to the semi-finals, and the rest of the teams will play in the classification matches, if applicable.

- 2.2.4 Phase 2: Semi-Finals: 1A vs 2B and 2A vs 1B.
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.2.5 If there are 6 teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5th & 6th positions.
- 2.2.6 If there are 7 teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5th, 6th and 7th positions.
- 3rd Ranked team of the 4-team group will advance to the 5th/6th position match.
 - 4th Ranked team will compete with the 3rd Ranked team of the 3-team group – winner to advance to the 5th/6th position match, and loser will be placed in 7th position.
- 2.2.7 This is to ensure that all teams get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.

2.3 Ranking of Teams in Phase 1 (Round Robin League Phase)

- 2.3.1 The following league points system will apply:

| Win | 2 points |
| Loss | 1 point |
| Loss by forfeit | 0 point |
- 2.3.2 The ranking within the group is determined by the greater number of league points obtained in all group matches.
- 2.3.3 If 2 teams ended the phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the results of the match between the 2 teams involved will be used to determine the ranking.
- 2.3.4 If 3 or more teams ended the phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, a second classification will be established using only the results of the matches between these involved teams.
- 2.3.5 If at any stage of this procedure the number of teams with equal league points is reduced to 2 teams, the procedure in 2.3.3 above will be applied.
- 2.3.6 If in the second classification there are still teams with equal league points, the goal average will be used to determine the ranking, using only results of matches between the involved teams.
- 2.3.7 If there are still more than 2 teams with the same goal average, the ranking will be determined using the goal average from the results of all their matches played in the group.
- 2.3.8 If at any stage of this procedure the number of teams with equal league points is reduced but still involves 3 or more teams, the procedure beginning with 2.3.4 will be repeated.
- 2.3.9 Goal average will always be calculated by division.

2.4 Match Attire and Jersey Numbers

- 2.4.1 The attire and numbers on the jersey of the players must comply with FIBA standard. Throughout the competition, the names and numbers of the players must remain the same as declared on the official list. The number on the players' jersey shall be confirmed at the General Technical Meeting by representatives of each team before the start of the tournament.
- 2.4.2 Teams shall only use numbers from 0 to 99.
- 2.4.3 Teams must have a minimum of 2 sets of attires and the first team named in the programme (home team) shall wear light-coloured attire (preferably white). The second team named in the programme (visiting team) shall wear dark-coloured attire. However, if the 2 teams agree, they may interchange the colours of the attire.
- 2.4.4 Shorts must be the same dominant colour as the shirts (front and back).
