NETBALL RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG Netball competition will be organised in accordance with:
 - 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the World Netball (WN).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following:
 - 1.2.1 Women's Tournament
- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
 - 1.3.1 1 Women's Team: Maximum of 12 players and 3 team officials.
- 1.4 Each country participating in the respective netball tournaments must bring with them the following number of International Technical Official (ITO):
 - 1.4.1 Women's Tournament: 1 International WN referee or National Tier 1 elite referee.

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 2.1 Competition Format - with 5 teams or less teams
 - 2.1.1 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played in which the teams shall play against each other in a single group league to decide the ranking of the team.
 - 2.1.2 Phase 2: The teams ranked 1st & 2nd will play the gold medal match and the teams ranked 3rd & 4th will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.2 Competition Format - with 6 or more teams
 - 2.2.1 The competition will be divided into 2 groups, Group A & Group B, in which the winner in the previous AUG netball competition shall be seeded in Group A and the silver medal team in Group B.
 - 2.2.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and also the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.
 - 2.2.3 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 2 groups in which the teams shall play against each other. The top 2 ranked teams of each group will advance to the semi-finals, and the rest of the teams will play in the classification matches, if applicable.

- 2.2.4 Phase 2: Semi-Finals: 1A vs 2B and 2A vs 1B.
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.

Should there be a tie in the scores of the games played in Phase 2, an extra time of 5 minutes each half (with 1 min interval between each half) will be played to determine the winner. An interval of 5 minutes at the end of full-time will apply before the extra time. If a draw occurs again after extra time, play will continue with a visual signal at the official bench and the team that scores 2 goals more than the other will emerge as the winner.

- 2.2.5 If there are 6 teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5th & 6th positions.
- 2.2.6 If there are 7 teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5th, 6th and 7th positions.
- 2.2.6.1 3rd Ranked team of the 4-team group will advance to the 5th/6th position match.
- 2.2.6.2 4th Ranked team will compete with the 3rd Ranked team of the 3-team group – winner to advance to the 5th/6th position match, and loser will be placed in 7th position.
- 2.2.7 This is to ensure that all teams get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.

2.3 Ranking of Teams in Phase 1 (Round Robin League Phase)

- 2.3.1 The following league points system will apply:

| Win | 3 points |
| Draw | 1 point |
| Loss | 0 point |
- 2.3.2 The ranking within the group is determined by the greater number of league points obtained in all group matches.
- 2.3.3 If two (2) teams ended the phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the results of the match between the 2 teams involved will be used to determine the ranking.
- 2.3.4 If 3 or more teams end the phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, a second classification will be established using only the results of the matches between these involved teams.
- 2.3.5 If at any stage of this procedure the number of teams with equal league points is reduced to 2 teams, the procedure in 2.3.3 above will be applied.
- 2.3.6 If in the second classification there are still teams with equal league points, the goal average will be used to determine the

ranking, using only results of matches between the teams involved.

2.3.7 If there are still more than 2 teams with the same goal average, the ranking will be determined using the goal average from the results of all their matches played in the group.

2.3.8 If at any stage of this procedure the number of teams with equal league points is reduced but still involves 3 or more teams, the procedure beginning with 2.3.4 will be repeated.

2.3.9 Goal average will always be calculated by division.

2.4 Game Duration

The game consists of four quarters of 15 minutes (effective time), with intervals of 3 minutes after the first and third quarters, and a half-time of 5 minutes.

2.5 Uniform

The uniform of the players must comply with WN standard.
