PETANQUE RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG Petanque competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the Federation International de Petanque et Jeu Provincial (FIPJP).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following 11 events:

Men	Women	Mixed
Singles (M1)	Singles (W1)	
Doubles (M2, No sub)	Doubles (W2, No sub)	Doubles (1M, 1W)
Shooting (M1)	Shooting (W1)	Triple (1M, 2W, No Sub)
Triples (M3, No Sub)	Triples (W3, No Sub)	Triple (2M, 1W, No Sub)

- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 13.1 A maximum of 9 men competitors, 9 women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
 - 1.3.2 A maximum of 2 entries per event except for the Triples events where there shall be only 1 entry per Triples event.
 - 1.3.3 Each competitor can compete up to a maximum of 3 events only (1 single event, 2 team events).

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 2.1 Competition Format – Precision Shooting
- 2.1.1 All competitors shall be played in 1st Round.
 - 2.1.2 The top 4 competitors shall be qualified to 2nd round automatically.
 - 2.1.3 Another 8 competitors with highest points (ranking 5 – 8) shall played for repechage round to qualify to the quarter finals.
 - 2.1.4 Losers of semi-finals will compete in the bronze medal match.
 - 2.1.5 Winners of the semi-finals will compete in the gold medal match.

2.2 Competition Format – Swiss System

2.2.1 Round 1: A Swiss system shall be played with:

- a. 3 matches for 4 entries/matches or 4 matches for 5 – 8 entries/teams or 5 matches for 9 and above entries/teams which the entries/teams shall play against each other in to decide the ranking of the team.

2.2.2 If there are more than 9 entries/teams, the top 8 entries/teams will be qualified to the 2nd round.

2.2.3 If there are only 8 entries, the top 4 entries/teams will qualify to semi-finals.

2.2.4 Round 2: A knock-out system shall be played.

2.2.5 Losers of semi-finals will compete in the bronze medal match.

2.2.6 Winners of the semi-finals will compete in the gold medal match.

2.2.7 Each match shall play 60 minutes + 1 end.

2.2.8 The deciding end shall be played if both entries/teams are tied after the extra end is completed. The jack cannot die during the end of the determination, the jack shall be returned to the last position before dead.

2.5 Match Attire

2.5.1 The attire of the players must comply with FIPJP standard.
